SUBJECT: H.M.FORTS ( AT SEA)

28th and 29th Sept.1914.

These forts are constructed in Port and then towed and sunk up to 15 miles from the Coast.

There are two types.... (1) Naval. Built on two cylinders of concrete. (2) Military. a series of seven forts connected by footbridges or catwalks.

They are used.- Anti-Sea-mining by the Luftwaffe - Anti A.A. - Anti-E.Boat - submarine.

Maintenance of off-shore communications and convoys - Only the guns are visible - all other instruments are under "cover"

There are seven forts placed outside the Mouth of the Thames.  
4 Naval - 3 military.
