1.	This material was started in case any incidents took place later. The K.K.E. organisation - which is the left wing of the larger party ELAS, whose fighting guerillas did such excellent work in the liberation of Greece - decided to celebrate their 26th anniversary with a parade etc. There was a likelihood that counter-demonstrations might take place and lead to trouble, hence this story was started as a basis.				
2.	From all over Athens parties gathered in Constitution Square wreaths were laid upon the tomb of Greece's Unknown Soldier and then upon a special monument erected to the men who fell in the liberation struggle. This far things went very well and then speeches began. Soon however every party or group was either singing or shouting some patriotic slogan or some variation - musical or otherwise of the party initials "Kappa Kappa Epsilon" The result was that everyone let off steam completely and so far things have fortunately gone off quietly.				
3.	ROLL ONE. shows laying of wreaths on the tomb of the Unknown Soldier, ROLL TWO. laying of wreaths of special memorial to dead in liberation struggles. General high views of crowd. ROLL THREE. Various shots of crowd, close-ups of people shouting etc etc				
4.	This demonstration should not be taken as being too "red". Most of the slogans were "Death to the Fascists" and similar things, "Long live our Allies" was also a very popular theme. It was more a case of letting off steam.
