Dear Mr. Partington,

With reference to the notes I sent you for the commentary on the film of the Ministry of Works Demonstration Houses at Northolt on November 14, on re-reading these, we find there are two corrections which should be made.

At the end of the second paragraph under the heading 'The Two Brick Terraced Houses', continuing the last line - "the production of the gas and coke needed for this service requires only 3 to 4 tons of coal per household per year" the following phrase should be added - "as compared with 5 to 6 tons for the average house."

And the other correction we should like made is the word 'coal' changed to 'coke' in the 7th line in the paragraph "The Living Room" under (Second House Filmed) :- the sentence should read:-

"When the fire is banked up and the damper closed it burns approximately 1 lb. of coke per hour....."

We should appreciate it if you could have these two alterations made in the commentary.
