DESCRIPTION:

Co's G, H, & I, 3rd Bn., ~~325th~~ Glider Inf., Regt., 82nd A/B Div. FUSA, supported by tanks of 740th Tank Bn., and tank destroyers of ~~325th~~ T.D. Bn., plow through outer defenses of the Siegfried Line into Neuhoof, Germany. The 82nd is forging into the base of what was formerly the German bulge in our lines.

ROLL 1

3rd Bn., men rolling up to jump off point in 2½ ton trucks pass burning German Tiger tank knocked out earlier by ~~629th~~ T.D. Bn. After dismounting men of Co. G, ~~325th~~ Glider Regt, filter into woods. Further up, they meet the tank and T.D. column, which is passing through dragons teeth of Siegfried Line. Shots of tanks and TD.'s moving through dragons teeth in foreground.

Jerry prisoners bringing out their wounded through dragons teeth, tanks in background. Co. G, ~~325th~~ moves up tank column passing dead Germans and GI's in fox-holes. Tanks and TD.'s fire 30 cal. and 50 cal. machine guns overhead as men of Co G, advance on Neuhoof, which can be seen in hollow 500 yards forward. Several houses are burning from artillery hits. Tankmen and infantrymen huddle against rear of pill-box at outskirts of Neuhoof. Pill-box was taken shortly before, unoccupied.

DESCRIPTION : Roll 2 & 3
This is Dam [redacted] one of the objectives of the 9th Division in the present offensive. This dam was also one of the V Corps objectives in their attack of December 11, 12 and 13th, just before the German break through. We now hold control over this dam after the attack yesterday by the 1st Battalion, 47th Regiment, 9th Division. The pictures were taken from a hill top on the south side of the dam. This is the foremost [redacted] position of the 47th Regiment, which is spearheading the 9th Division attack. This position is held by the 1st Squad., 1st Platoon, CO "A", 1st Battalion, 47th Regiment, 9th Division. These waters are part of the Ruer River. 125 feet of the 200 feet exposed here shows the dam and the surrounding water with the large craters, partially surrounding the dam area. The dam has been damaged to some extent and fresh wooden foot walk has been placed across the top. On the far hillside are pill boxes, bunkers, partially demolished. 75 feet--- Enemy soldiers attempted to reach the dam and pill-boxes. Sgt. Tommy Hawthorn, of Warsaw, Indiana, whose Squad holds this [redacted] position welcomes them with some BAR fire. Two soldiers reach the one pill box and were seen, through field glasses, to stick their heads out of an opening. A few more rounds were fired into the opening and nothing more was observed. When a small group of enemy soldiers was observed on the East side of the lake, the riflemen of the first squad fired on them and they pulled back.
