As the SEAC Peace negotiations were in progress, large conveys of British and Indian troops set sail for Singapore.

Japanese Envoys met the Cruiser Sussex in Sigapore waters and arranged a local unconditional surrender.

A few hours later assault eraft left the cenvoy and secured the small Islands just off Singapore, these were the Islands where we had our Coastal defences before the Jap Occupation.

Once these islands were held by our troops and the gun position taken over, the main convoy sailed in and tied up.

Immediately the Indian troops occupied parts of the town while a token force of Japanese were left behind to do police duties until we were ready to take ever completely.

The welcome in the town compared with those in Europe. Chinese people went crazy, throwing fire crakers on the ground etc.
