	<p>The annual soccer game in medieval costume, which is preceded and followed by a colorful parade (also in costume) took place at Florence. Contenders were the "Whites" (from the Santo Spirito section of the city) and the "Blues" (From the Santa Croce section). The former represented the left bank and the latter the right bank of the Arno river.</p> <p>This year the game was held in the suggestive Square of the Signoria rich in famous monument where a great crowd of foreign and Italian tourists had gathered to view it. The teams filed in to the sound of drums and the blare of trumpets. The contestants "saluted the authorities" and then the herald the Signoria read his traditional message.</p> <p>The game it self then began "no holds or tricks barred" as was customary in the times when the classical game first took place. The first game was held in the year 1530 to mock the enemy. (One section of the City in those times was for the city's independence and the other was favourable to Philip of Orleans who under the orders of Pope Clement VII wanted to place the Medici family as rulers of the city.</p> <p>The public took great interest in the game. which The game was won by the "whites".</p>
