

TRAIN WRECK AT SLEAFORD.

On a run from York to Lowestoft this Boat Train left the rails near Sleaford in Lincolnshire and became a mass of wreckage, Three men were killed --- three platelayers who sat at lunch in their hut beside the line, while two more of them were injured. The Passengers had lucky escapes -- only five being slightly injured. Tragic as this accident is, it serves to emphasis the normal safety of Britain's railways.
