inspected by the Duke of Abercorn, Governor of Northern Ireland.

Early in the morning a steady drizzle had greeted several boatloads of enthusiastic Welsimen on arrival at Belfast Quayside, and although the majority were wet to the skin when the game started it failed to damp their ardour. Wales were in red jerseys and dark shorts, Ireland playing in green jerseys and whiteshorts, and although both found the going heavy at first the game soon became interesting. Wales touched down once, but the try was disallowed. Thirty-two minutes after the start W:G:Legge of Newport scored a penalty goal from the touchline.

In the second half Bailey scored a try which S.Walker converted, and the final score was Ireland 5 --- Wales 3.
