The Cambria brought from Ireland to England Mr De Valera and his Ministers for Commerce, Finance and Agriculture. The purpose of the visit was a consultation with Mr Neville Chamberlain --- topics under discussion including British and Free State Defence, and an united Ireland to iclude Ulster. Tremendous crowds awaited them at Euston, and our cameraman sought an exclusive interview at the Ri Piccadilly Hotel. But The Prime Minister wouldn't talk, reserving his remarks for the British Prime Minister.
