

MEETING IN MUNICH.

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The train from Italy drew into the station at Kufstein, on the old Austro-Italian border; and Signor Mussolini attending the Four-Power Conference was greeted by Herr Hitler. The Band played for Il Duce the Italian National Anthem. Then for the Fuehrer, Deutschland Ueber Alles. M. Daladier arrived from France by plane. At the Munich Airport he was welcomed with the Marseillaise. The French Premier drove to his hotel with Herr von Ribbentrop, and Germany's Foreign Minister then returned to receive Mr Chamberlain. In little more than one hour after this last arrival, the Four-Power Conference was at work. In the sombre Fuehrerhaus in Munich, four men of destiny laboured to reach agreement. All the details of handing over the Sudeten Territory to Germany were discussed --- the dates and the manner of taking over and the new frontiers on the map of Europe. And we give you history in the making --- the actual signing of the ~~Anglo-German Peace Pact~~ ^{Agreement which meant peace for Europe} of Peace. The decisions arrived at in Munich concerning Czechoslovakia were placed immediately before the Government in Prague --- under the Premiership of General Syrovky it was agreed that Czechoslovakia would subordinate her own interests to those of the peace of the world. After that meeting Britain awaited eagerly the return of its Prime Minister --- its statesman-hero. And at home in London Mrs Chamberlain awaited the return of her husband. In his absence she took her daily walk alone --- alone, yet with a wealth of companionship in the emotion of grateful hearts.
