

CANOE DISCOVERY AT NOTTINGHAM.

No stranger craft ever came up from the river Trent than these ~~two~~-relics of the Varsity boat race of 2000 years ago. Gaumont British News cameraman took these exclusive pictures which show the 30 odd men who were needed to handle these giants of the primeval forest, 31 ft long, and 2ft 9 ins wide. Cut out of solid oak, they were recovered during dredging operations near Clifton Grove. Traces of an early British settlement were also found in the shape of six beautifully marked bronze ~~a~~ spear heads. ~~xxx~~ So ^{two} ~~these~~ wonderful specimens of ancient history were removed from the moat at Nottingham Castle to their final resting place in the Museum.
