At Gravesend we interviewed Mr C.W.A. Scott and Mrs Kirby Green getting ready for their ~~attempt on the Cape record~~ *flight to Australia*

And at Uroydon we interviewed a new aeroplane. The Frobisher is of the Albatross type with accommodation for 22 passengers with their luggage. But come aloft with our cameraman and fly alongside --- ~~see how she rides the sky like a battleship of the clouds.~~ *Frobisher* ~~She~~ has a range of 1,000 miles fully loaded and a normal cruising speed of 210 miles an hour ~~— see how~~ *she rides the sky as steadily as a battleship in a calm sea*

This plane is a development of the Comet ~~plane~~ *two-day* which made the ~~fast~~ *present* Australia record and which is being used for the attempt. Incidentally, the first trip from London to Paris in less than one hour was made in the Comet in 1935.
