The wonderful impression of friendliness made by the King and Queen in Washington had preceded them to New York. And although the actual landing ceremony was unexpectedly simple for Manhattan, it was the slightly shy official welcome of the greatest city in the new world for welcome visitors from the greatest of the old. Their ajestles were met by Mayor la Guardia --- Mayor of New York.

These pictures were flown across the Atlantic and establish a new record in the time between an event in New York and its presentation in Britain --- but a fuller account will appear

And so they came to the World's Fair. Here again their simplicity and charm conquered the American hearts. They have left behind them a better appreciation of the majaxix problems of the British Empire. They have created an understanding of far greater value than any modern pact.
