FRANCE'S AIR FORCE.

Already the Air Force of Britain's great ally has demonstrated its superiority over the German. These pictures of the French Air Force taken before the war are therefore of especial interest now. They show how the mighty power of the wings of France goes into action. Look at these enormous bombs --- presently we shall see them expladexxkefsrexenry hit their target with a colossal roar --- and while they load up, consider what aircraft France can use in attack. The 16-ton Farman --- the Amiot --- the Bloch --- dreadnoughts of the air that carry huge loads of explosive to ahatter the enemy gun emplacements.
