The last meeting of the three kings was in 1914 when they also
discussed the problem of staying out of the war. This time
the question of Soviet relations with Finland was an addition
to the agenda. Next to President Kallio is King Haakon of Hormay on the other side of White-haired King Gustav of Sweden is King
Christian of Denmark. At the end of the Conference a joint
communique was issued declaring the right of these Nordic nations
to adhere to their traditional policy of neutrality.
