These are the pictures of the armistice signed by French Indochina and Thailand, which used to be called Siam. This border war
has had every aspect of artificialty; it seems to unreal beside the
great conflict that engages half the rest of the world. But behind
this apparently trivial dispute stands the shadow of Japan,
her policy of making China a land fit for Japanese to live in.

The negotiations and signatures were made on board a Japanese warship in the harbour at Saigon. Thailand was represented by 5 Peacemaker delegates, French Indo-China by 5 and Japan the madiatar by 7.

It is understood that Japan is quite satisfied with the result.
