But the best function of the is not tee bad: A we fulfilled our obligation to help our gallant Balkan ally in its lone stand; we inflicted heavy casualties on the enemy: and in this sparring preliminary our commanders and our men have got the measure of the German army. This brief record of one small episode in that fierce battle, shows supplies and reinforcements going into the Allied positions: and they show that our men were undismayed to the measure.
