NAZI PIRACY HITS AMERICAN ON THE HIGH SEAS.

A Brazilian freighter coming in to Pernambuco carried eleven survivors of the American steamship Robin Moor^{which a U-Boat torpedoed.} They had drifted for 13 days in an open boat before being picked up. Full details have been reported to Washington on this first case of an American ship sunk by Nazis.

Some of the ^{American} survivors of the Egyptian ship Zamzam arrived in Spain after Nazis had torpedoed the ship in the Atlantic. One of the children on board the doomed vessel described her experience for our cameras.

The survivors were cared for by the Red Cross and after a roundabout journey through occupied France and Spain were sent home.

America strikes back by taking possession of ships in her ports which belong to Germany and Italy or countries controlled by them. Coastguards have been sent aboard Danish ships, which will sail in future beneath the stars and Stripes. And there's another side to this story of America and the ~~freedom~~ freedom of the seas. Pictures from Marseilles show the distribution of food sent from the United States for hungry children in France. But Vichy collaboration with Germany raises doubts as to whether much of this food doesn't find its way into the Nazi stores. Those who partner Germany are not permitted to have feelings of common humanity.
