TANK DESTROYERS.

Another solid fact in American production; new tank destroyers coming off the lines in a Michigan war factory ready for a try-out.

These land destroyers are faster and more manoeuvrable than tanks; highly mobile anti-tank guns with terrific fire power: and capable of operating in the worst possible kind of country.

MOBILE FIELD GUNS.

Mobile Field Guns --- also the product of American factories. Big guns that are no longer anchored to one position, but able to follow up an advancing army and back it up with shells like a naval bombardment.

They can be dismantled for travel at grouter speed -- and securitied again with speed. Their tracks and bilden -- they are camouflaged and when they go off everything near them goes off too.
MILITARY HIGHWAY.

To follow up those two items of production --- one of the roads that carry them. It's the Harrisburg Turnpike --- the highway from Harrisburg to Pittsburgh. What is more important is that this is one of America's main arteries for the transport of war material. Twenty-one million pounds of war goods travel it every day --- from factory to dock and dock to front line. And that's another headache for Hitler,
