THE QUEBEC CONFERENCE.

Further pictures from Canada of the meeting of Allied Chiefs. These discussions have entirely usurped the interest that used to be aroused ~~around~~/when Hitler met Mussolini; ~~but~~ nowadays Hitler has practically nobody left to meet.

A Flying Boat arrived bringing further representatives to the Conference, among them Mr. Anthony Eden and Mr. Brendan Bracken. They very kindly posed for the cameramen who were waiting for them and went into conference having done their good deed for the day.

In this group with Mr. Churchill and Mr. Roosevelt are the Earl and Countess of Athlone, the Earl, of course, being Governor General of Canada.

Around the Conference table the British and American Chiefs of Staff worked out the problems of Allied strategy; a notable representative being Lord Louis Mountbatten whose appointment as ~~Sup~~ Supreme Allied Commander in South East Asia was announced ~~later~~.

Thus the egg of victory was laid; we shall wait to see it hatched in Berlin and Tokyo.
