

Big Four meet in East Berlin-

Feb 2nd. 1954.

From the American Zone of Berlin, the Big Four talks have moved to the Russian sector of the city.

And for the first time, cameramen have been allowed to wander at will, recording life behind the Iron Curtain. But strict traffic checks are still made where East meets West at the Brandenburg Gate - ^{that} ~~an~~ historic city landmark.

This time, the background to the Talks is the Soviet Embassy, situated in the famous "Unter den Linden" - the Bond Street of the German Capital, which is guarded day and night by Russian soldiers.

But it still seems rather difficult to get on friendly terms with the Russians, both outside and at the conference table. For Mr Molotov countered the Western proposals for the re-unification of Germany, with a ~~bitter~~ blast as bitter as ^{MID-WINTER} ~~our present~~ temperatures.
