

New York: An emergency Sunday session of the United Nations Security Council hears a complaint by the Guatemalan delegate that his country has been the victim of "open aggression" by the neighbouring Republics of Honduras and Nicaragua.

During the debate, the Soviet Delegate vetoed a resolution that the matter be referred to a local Inter-American inquiry.

A move that brought sharp words of warning from Mr Henry Lodge, the U.S. delegate. SOUND

The verbal battle over, the Security Council unanimously adopted a French amendment calling for a "cease-fire". Meanwhile, the invasion, led by Guatemalan rebels has met with little success in this Central American country.
