

### Canadian Parliament changes

Canada: After tendering his resignation continuare as Premier,
Mr St. Laurent leaves Government House, Ottawa - as leader
of the Opposition.

This change of leadership followed the first Conservative election wister victory for 22 years - and Mr Diefenbaker's new Cabinet - includes Canada's first woman member.

Following the swearing-in ceremony, the Governor-General, Mr Massey, poses with the Administration that will guide Canada through coming years of expansion.

#### New Tanker Launched

Glasgow: Confirming the rapid expansion of the British Petroleum Tanker Fleet - the 32,000 ton vessel "British Trader" is launched on Clydebank. Built at the famous John Brown yards - the new rasselveitles oil tanker will be followed by five more of the same class.

This expansion follows the Suez crisis - when Britain's industrial machine was threatened by oil starvation. Meanwhile, another twenty-six vessels have been ordered from British yards - seven of them 65,000 ton giant tankers.
