Canada: After tendering his resignation ~~after a brief career~~ as Premier, ~~Mr. St. Laurent~~ Mr St. Laurent, leaves Government House, Ottawa - as leader of the Opposition.

Puerto Rico: New-style Commando operations bring 20th century realism to the romantic Caribbean. U.S. Marines inflate rubber invasion boats on the decks of a submarine.

All set - the submarine submerges, and these new-style craft (that can carry over a ton), transport the heavily-armed shock-troops ashore - on a reconnaissance or raiding mission.

New Tanker Launched

Glasgow: Confirming the rapid expansion of the British Petroleum Tanker Fleet - the 32,000 ton vessel "British Trader" is launched on Clydebank. Built at the famous John Brown yards - the new ~~vessel~~ oil tanker will be followed by five more of the same class.

This expansion follows the Suez crisis - when Britain's industrial machine was threatened by oil starvation. Meanwhile, another twenty-six vessels have been ordered from British yards - seven of them 65,000 ton giant tankers.
