

3rd TRAIN DISASTER IN A WEEK
EXPRESS SLEEPER CRASHES.

In the third fatal railway disaster in six days, twelve people lost their lives and twenty others were injured. The London to Newcastle express sleeper smashed into some derailed wagons five miles from Ferryhill Station, County Durham. These shots were taken while victims were still trapped in the wreckage. Among passengers who escaped with a shaking was the Home Secretary, Mr. Chuter Ede. Interviewed after the crash, he said, "I don't know how anyone escaped alive from the first three coaches." Bringing the death roll up to thirty four, the Ferryhill crash rounds off a Black week for Britain's railways.
