On arrival, she inspected a Guard of Henour of 80 Army Gadets, who were later called out to control the 5,800 eroud which broke through the berriers, nearly stampeding the cattle on show. With the Himister of Agriculture and the Lord Lieutement of Garmarthea, the Princess had a word for Welsh Lond Army Girls, and to wismore of the Society's livestock competitions she smarded prizes. To the farmers of Britain in the orisis she gave a royal message of encouragement.
