It's not that I'm against nationalization, because I believe that nationalization is right it's the machine that carries me and the machine that I don't believe in.

4. M.S. J.P. One point we would like to ask Sir, is there any political angle to this move.

(Sir Charles) I would like to make it clear that I do not wish either my resignation or the statement that I made to be used against the Government, as I said before Nationalization is right and I shall be no party to anything of that kind. It is a national question not a party one. 86 ft.
