## FIRE BLASTS DUTCH FOOD STORES

Fire sweeps Amsterdam's harbour front, as two large cold storage wavehouses go up in flames. Fanned by a stiff wind, the blase secures a firm grip on the decord buildings, and firemen, called from a 30-wile radius, battle to save the deckyard.

Europe's largest refrigerating store, the warehouses held several million tens of feed mostly for expert - and included 45 million eggs. Some crates are salvaged by resous teams, but the bulk of the feed - sufficient for one week's rations for the whole of Britain - is destroyed. Cause of the blase is still a mystery.
