

HIG LEEDS A.F.S. TEST

It's a proper big do at Leeds, with sixty or seventy contingents from thirty cities and towns in Yorkshire taking part. It's part of a drive to get more men and women to join Civil Defence. For the exercise, the area between Leeds Bridge and Old Mill Lane, Hunslet, is badly hit and calls for help.

Rescue-workers go into action. The exercise is the first of its kind to be held in the North-East counties, and more than 500 volunteers are taking part. The casualties are enacted with help from the British Red Cross. To avoid damage to the buildings, the firemen pump water back into the river.

The W.V.S. have a Queen's convey in action. In fact all branches of Civil Defence are engaged in this important exercise which has its message for everyone, everywhere.
