Supporters embrace the leader of the Liberation Army — General

Gastillo Armas — who spearheaded the rebellion that overthrew

Guatemala's leftist regime.

At the Presidential Palace in San Salvador, behind locked and guarded doors, the rebels and the anti-Red military junta ruling the country meet to negotiate a peace.

El Salvador's president, Oscar Oscrio, acts as mediator in the talks. Arriving from Guatemala City is Colonel Efego Monson -- head of the anti-Red Junta in the country's capital.

In the talks, Armas agrees to faxmax join a new junta and pledges to join Monzon in banishing communism, reestablishing constitutional government and holding new elections.
