Jubilant soldiers celebrate th victory in their two-week old revolt in these latest films from the insurgent base at Esquipulas.

Supporters embrace the leader of the Liberation Army -- General Castillo Armas -- who spearheaded the rebellion that overthrew Guatemala's leftist regime.

At the Presidential Palace in San Salvador, behind locked and guarded doors, the rebels and the anti-Red military junta ruling the country meet to negotiate a peace.

El Salvador's president, Oscar Osorio, acts as mediator in the talks. Arriving from Guatemala City is Colonel Efege Monzon -- head of the anti-Red junta in the country's capital.

In the talks, Armas agrees to ~~xxxxxx~~ join a new junta and pledges to join Monzon in banishing communism, reestablishing constitutional government and holding new elections.
