WHO ELSE COVERED All.

Queen Mother Elizabeth of Great Britain arrives in New York aboard the Queen Elizabeth for a twenty four day tour of the United States and Canada.

As the ship stands into her pier, the Queen Mother joins the pilot on the starboard wing of the bridge, providing an unscheduled shot for the photographers.

In the ship's Verandah Grill, the Queen Mother is welcomed by John Simmons, our Chief of Protocol, and Amb. Patterson of the Mayor's Committee. She replies. Following her brief remarks, she is presented with a number of Commonwealth consular officials and their wives and several others.

WHO ELSE COVERED ALL.

The Queen Mother Elizabeth arrived in New York this evening aboard the

liner Queen Elizabeth. The liner docked twelve hours late due to heavy
seas enroute. As the liner docked at Pier 90, North River the Queen Mother
observed the procedures from the flying bridge of the liner. An hour and
a half later she entered the Verandah Grill of the liner to meet a barrage
of photographers and reporters plus the diplomatic corps of the Commonwealth
countries and officials of the City of New York. After addressing her remarks
into the microphones she stepped back to receive the diplomatic and city
officials. She then proceeded to the gangway at the top of which she said
her goodbyes to the Captain of the ship. She then stepped down the gangway
to put her feet on United States soil.

WE were not able to get shots of the Queen Mother at the foot of the gangway
This was due to restrictions placed on everyone in the Verandah Grill, covering
the activities there. No one was allowed to leave the room until after the
Queen Mother left the ship.
