From a rostrum in front of the Mansion House, Alderman Seymour Howard, London's new Lord Mayor, watches the traditional procession through the City streets, and then takes his place in the 200 year old scarlet and gold coach. At the rear of the parade he drives to the Law Courts for the customary inauguration ceremony. As always, there's second to none marching from the Senior Service.
