

"BEAU BRUMMELL" is the ninth film to be selected for presentation to the Royal Family. The Performance tonight is estimated to realise £30,000. To date the Royal Film Performances, and replica Provincial Shows have amassed a total of £203,940.

BOUQUETS:

The bouquet being presented to Her Majesty, The Queen, by Master Nicholas Hawkins, is made up of pink and mauve orchids, freesias and lilies of the valley.

A bouquet of pink roses, mixed freesias and lilies of the valley, will be presented to H.R.H. Princess Margaret, by Master Nicholas Roylance.

The large screen television presentation is by J. Arthur Rank's Screen Services Limited.
