Queen Elizabeth the Queen Mother and Princess Margaret attend a private dress show staged for them by the Incorporated Society of London Fashion Designers. This means that all the big names in British fashion will be contributing to the display which takes place at the home of Lady Camrose. One of the Queen's designers, Hardy Amies, created this lovely garden party dress in blue-printed white Cumberland nylon. He calls it Cornflower. Pamela Bradley is the model.
