"BLUEBIRD" UNVEILED:

Mr. Donald Campbell's "Bluebird" is unveiled at Sanlesbury's Engineering Works near Blackburn. The world's first all metal Turbo-jet hydroplane, the craft is designed to win back the water speed record from America. With another British speed king, George Eyston, Donald Campbell and his wife discuss the revolutionary new boat. Eyston was, of course, holder of the land speed record in the middle thirties.

The spare "Beryl" turbo-jet engine is capable of 4,000 thrust pounds at 8,000 revs per minute. Donald Campbell will soon begin trials at Ullswater prior to attempting to smash the present record of 179 miles an hour.
