Mrs Tyson appears to be in her early sixties, and is a very homely and pleasing lady. She was very nervous, and at first so much so that we thought an interview unlikely. However after some time taken "relaxing" her, she settled down and did fairly well. She appears to be quite overwhelmed by the shock of being thrust into headline news, and is very conscious of her North country dialect. She was worried about "all these people" looking at me (is the cinema audiences).

She has carefully kept with all the affection of a Mother his old c-ricket boots, and the set of Indian Clubs he has left at home.

Tyson appears to have taken all his County Caps etc with him on the trip.

He was very good at sports generally while at school, and there was ample evidence of his general prowess in the way of certificates and photos too numerous to include because of footage.
