

LONDON HOLDS PHOTOFAIR.

Photographic equipment never before seen in this country goes on show at the first post-war photo-fair. Here's the dearest camera on show - the Swedish Hasselblad, costing £900 - while from Germany comes this smallest cine-camera in the world, an 8 mm. model.

France sends an "Ocina" underwater camera complete in plastic case, while from the Russian zone of Germany comes the "Kelpofot" camera used for cancer research and similar work.

Opened by the Marquis of Ely - taking pictures of the bathing beauties present - the Fair puts the photographic industry back in the picture!
