Back to Lenden, to Paddington Resrection Ground, for enother mashed record. Gordon Pirio taskles the unofficial world time for the 1 and a half miles held by Hungary's Dares. That's Pirio on the outside.

All seven runners are off to a good start, and Pirio takes the lead from the beginning. Second is Ralph Bunkley with Ken Norris third.

How Pirio's way out on his own - but don't be feeled into thinking the others aren't making good time. This is a real mass-attack on the world record. Buttling for second place are Bunkley, Newris and Thorpo, in that order.

At the one mile mark, Gordon Parie has a 50 yard lead. The others can't touch him, though some of Paddington's kids have their own ambitions.

And in a splendid finish, Pirio knocks 5 point 2 seconds off
the world time. Therpo, second and Norris third, are 40 yards behind, but still
inside the world record. Bren Bunkley in fourth place, beats Chatemay's official
British time. Pirio's communt: "Too slow - I should have been faster" Some
people are never satisfied - but that's how records get broken.
