

ULSTER HONOURS CHURCHILL.

Two Ulster cities, Belfast and Londonderry, enrol Sir Winston Churchill on their lists of Freeman. A silver casket contains the certificate of the freedom of Belfast, presented by the Lord Mayor, Alderman R.J.R. Harcourt. It is a measure of Sir Winston's standing that the two cities come to him for the ceremony, which is held in the City of London, at the Mansion House. Belfast's Lady Mayoress presents a gift to Lady Churchill.

General Tompler and Earl Attlee are among the guests. The Mayor of Londonderry, Senator S. Dowds, presents his city's certificate of freedom in a silver cannon. It is a miniature of "Rearing Meg", which defended Londonderry when James the Second besieged it in 1689. Says the Mayor: "Sir Winston, you are now one of us. On behalf of your fellow citizens of Londonderry, I salute you"...
