

GIANT CARGO TRANSPORT**BARUCH -- Aarsoth**

In an age of giant aircraft, the Air Force rolls out the biggest of them all -- a one hundred twenty ton cargo plane -- half a football field long and with a tail four stories high.

A huge ramp can be lowered to permit the loading of more eighty thousand pounds of cargo -- twice the capacity of today's biggest military transports.

The cabin -- ninety feet long -- looks more like a hangar and will -- without squeezing -- carry more than two hundred fighting men. Powered by four turbo-prop engines, the C-133A will take to the air for the first time this spring.
