NEWS FLASHES.

The youngest daughter of the last Austrian Emperor is married in a Bavarian village of the Starnberger See. She is 35-year-old Charlotte of Habsburg-Torring, and Duke George of Mecklenburg is the groom. Groups in national costume represent the various Austrian provinces. Among the guests are representatives of five royal families; one ex-empress, one archduke; one arch-duchess; 23 princes and princesses; 17 dukes and duchesses and 14 counts and countesses. Even a few plain Herrs and Fraus - just to complete the picture.

Refugees leave the ruins of the Indian town of Anjar, in Kutch province, after an earthquake which made 12,000 people homeless in ten seconds of terror. Eight hundred houses are reduced to rubble, and rescuers face an immense task as they hunt for the trapped and injured. The sudden tremour made many roads almost impassible, which adds to the problem of bringing aid to the smashed towns. Over a hundred lives are known to have been lost - but the total death-roll may be much higher.
