Israel's armed Forces Commander in Chief and most popular hero of the Sinai Campaign, held his first press conference yesterday somewhere in Israel, before world newspapermen and reporters.

In his Press Conference General Moshe DAYAN explained the operations since Israel decided to attack Egypt in order to stop terrorist raids made by Egypt's Fedayans against Israeli border settlements. He readily answered all questions from reporters.

SAN FRANCISCO: FLEET HEADS FOR PACIFIC ASSIGNMENT (Wipe To)
TEXAS: TANKERS TAKEN OUT OF MOTHBALLS

A fleet of warships - 23 vessels in all - heads out to sea beneath San Francisco's Golden Gate Bridge. Sailing for emergency assignment in the Pacific - the fleet includes the carrier - Shangri-la - with a full complement of crewmen and planes. Their exact destinations are a secret - but the presence of a second carrier - the Yorktown - indicates the Navy is moving toward a war alert.

Meanwhile - the Middle East crisis and the blocking of the Suez Canal - brings hectic activity to the drydock at Beaumont, Texas. Giant tankers are being taken out of mothballs and prepared for active duty at sea. With more Navy units in action - tankers will be needed to refuel the fleet at sea. And ~~with~~ with the Suez Canal closed - many American tankers will be needed to ferry oil to Europe - which is expected to suffer a grave shortage in a matter of a few weeks.

Mr. HAMMARSKJOLD, THE UNO SECRETARY,
ARRIVES AT CAPODICHINO AIRPORT OF NAPLES

The UNO Secretary, Mr. Hammarskjöld, arrived in Naples from Rome on November 15th. His plane landed at Capodichino Airport at 6.45 p.m. after a flight which was delayed by stormy weather.

HAMMARSKJOLD IN ROME

On his way to Cairo, the UN Secretary General Dag Hammarskjold is arrived yesterday at 15.10 at Ciampino Airport (Rome) from New York. At the Airport were to welcome him Ambassador Magistrati, Director General of Political Affaires, Maj. Gen. E.L.M. Burns of Canada, the Commander of UN force, Italian General Raffaelli of the Air force, the Vice-director of FAO Brodley, Ambassador of Sweden Von Post, and the attaché of USA Jernegan.

Mr. Hammarskjold upon his arrival, stayed in the Airport building for about two-hours consultations with Maj.Gen. BURNS.

At 17.30 He left aboard a military plane for Capodichino Airport(Naples).
