

CELTIC v. KILMARNOCK:

REPLAY:

Celtic (in the white shirts) meet Kilmarnock at Hampden Park in the Scottish F.A. Cup Semi-Final replay. There's only one change from their first meeting Toner for Dougan as Celtic centre-half so the two sides have the measure of each other and it's a real tough battle right from the start. Goalie Brown stops a Celtic rush.

He clears upfield - and in a matter of seconds, it's the Celtic goal that's under attack. The Celtic keeper, Beattie, brings Curlett down inside the box - a penalty for Killie. Beattie saves - but Gerry Mays follows up and scores!

Now Celtic are fighting hard to wipe out the Killie lead, Killie fend off the attack - but it's out to the right wing for another try, it's centred - and from close range Collins bangs it in the equaliser!

Celtic fans are wild with joy - but Kilmarnock sweep back - a cross from Curlett - and Mays heads a beauty!

Second half, and Kilmarnock leading 2 - 1. Celtic stage an all-out attack on the Killie goal - but no matter how hard they press, the Kilmarnock defence holds. Celtic have switched their forward line, putting Alex Byrne at outside left and Mochan at centre - but that doesn't seem to help them any.

Finally right winger Gerry Mays gets it away and clears upfield to start a lightening attack - and Black finds the empty goal.

So it's a three-one finish - and Kilmarnock to meet Falkirk in the final!
