

PREMIERE OF "WOMAN IN A DRESSING GOWN".

The gala premiere of "Woman in a Dressing Gown" takes place this Thursday, October 3rd, at the Warner Theatre, Leicester Square,

The performance starts at 8.45 p.m., and guests will start to arrive by 8p.m. so it is suggested that photographers should be at the theatre by 8.p.m. wherever possible.

A large number of stars have accepted invitations to attend the premiere, but this will be an opening night with a difference, because for once, the general public will have a chance to attend a big, West End premiere: from all the main ABC theatres, nearly 400 couples have been chosen at random, from among the audiences, and invited to the premiere. In this way, the regular cinema-goer, who attends his or her local, will have the chance to meet the stars who appear in the films they see; and the men behind the film, - Frank Godwin the producer, Ted Willis who wrote the screenplay and so on.

There will be a large glamour contingent, headed by June Cunningham; Sheena Marsh Cherie Danton; Madeleine Mono; Betty Le Beau; and Barbara Roscoe.

"Woman in a Dressing Gown" was an award-winning entry in the recent Berlin Film Festival, and opened to wide press acclaim in New York last month: it is a picture which has evoked widespread interest throughout the world, and its London premiere is an important event.
