

IS THIS ANASTASIA:

Near the little village of Unterlangenhardt, in the Black Forest, there's a wooden hut with a "Keep Out" notice - a broken-down home which hides a secret that has baffled the world for three decades. The world is curious - but the curious are not welcome here. Inside the hut lives a woman who may be the Grand Duchess Anastasia of Russia - or may be a nobody.
