

## NEW WAY TO BURN OLD AUTOS!

Power steering, power brakes, high fins or low, all good autos finally come to the end of the highway. But in New York City, for example, the open air burning of auto cracases has brought with it another problem - smoke pollution. This new plant in Brooklyn, New York, undertakes to reduce a heap to valuable scrap metal - without smoke.

The autos - stripped of motor, radiator, batteries and tires - are fed into the smoke-eliminating furnace and subjected for twenty minutes to temperatures of 15-hundred degrees fahrenheit.

The noxious smoke is drawn off to another chamber and consumed by complete combustion.

The finished shell is cooled off, ready for compressing. On a 24 hour basis, this plant could handle the 600 cars destroyed each day in New York - a boon, for a new city law will ban open air auto burning.
