SORAYA ARRIVES IN ROME

Princess Soraya, the green-eyed former Empress of Iran, arrived in Rome in the afternoon amidst increasing rumors of romance with a prince of one of Italy's most noble families. The prince, Raimondo Orsini, whose family has given Popes and cardinals to the Roman Catholic Church, did not meet her at Ciampino airfield.

In Frankfurt, where Soraya started her flight to Rome, the Iranian embassy described her journey as an Easter holiday.

At Rome's Ciampino airfield, police kept newsmen and photographers away from the beathful Soraya. More than a thousand persons jammed the spectators' roof to get a glimpse of the arriving princess. She traveled with her mother.

Two Iranian embassy automobiles stood by to pick up Soraya and her mother and drive her to Rome.

Soraya wore a black overcoat and red hat. She carried a bouquet of red and white carnations. She was the first to descend from the German plane upon its arrival here. Her mother followed her.

The Iranian ambassador to Rome and a number of other Iranian officials greeted her as she descended the ramp.
