At Hhoose airport near Cardiff in South Wales a "Cambrian" D.C.3	
is loaded with two tons of Christmas gifts collected by 29	
Welsh Innerwheel Clubs. They are going to refugee children	
at D.P.'s at Stocken and Schulenburg Camps near Hanover.	
Various shots during the flight show the parcels. Also flying	
shots through the windows.	
At Hanover Airport the 'plane is met by the Bergomaster of Hanover	
and representatives of United Nations.	
Mrs. Eileen Thorpe the Chairman of the International Committee	
of the South Wales Innerwheel seen shaking hands with the	
Bergomaster and is presented with bouquet by three Latvian	
D.P's .	
At Six Schulenberg Camp the remaining families four wives with	
children are given food parcels and the children toys.	
Various long shots of Camp buildings and huts.

The Suljagics are Yugoslavs.		
At the Camp At Stocken (Baltic Camp) many willing hands		
help to unload the lorry. From the Community Centre the		
inmates of the camp are handed their parcels of food and		
fruit and chickens etc.,		
The Authorities hope to have all camps closed by the end of		
1961. The largest of the camps still has 1000 inhabitants.		
The people find it difficult to change to normal living		
after years in the camps but they receive finanical help		
to move to flats being built by the Germans. D.P's are		
treated exactly the same as Germans..
