Operations "Wintershiels"

60,000 American, French and Federal German soldiers took part in the biggest post-war manoeuvres held in Bavaria, southwards of Regensburg.

The main object of the winter manoeuvres is to control the efficiency and fitness of the US-troops (troops) stationed in west Germany and to strengthen cooperation within NATO the American General Garrison H. Davidson is in command. More than 15,000 tanks and armoured cars are involved. 4,000 Germans with 1,500 motor-vehicles are participating.

The seven-day manoeuvres began in rain and snow showers. The manoeuvres have a defensive conception: repeal of an aggression and counter-attack.
